

Hawaii Prince Golf Club completed \$950K renovation

Hawaii Prince Golf Club underwent \$950,000 in renovations with changes to its signature restaurant and golf pro shop, which reopened Sept. 11, according to representatives of the golf course.

"Driven by our commitment to exceeding guest expectations, we invested in this renovation to elevate the overall experience at Hawaii Prince Golf Club," said Daniel Abergas, golf operations manager, in a written statement. "The refreshed look and feel of our signature restaurant, Bird of Paradise, and the Pro Shop will provide an even more enjoyable and welcoming atmosphere for our guests."

The golf course itself remained open during these renovations. As part of the upgrades, the Hawaii Prince Golf Pro Shop underwent changes to feature a similar color palette as its sister hotel, Prince Waikiki, including darker woods and warmer tones throughout the space.

The construction was completed by 87Zero. Hawaii Prince Golf Club is a 27-hole golf course, designed by Arnold Palmer and Ed Seay, which features 270 acres of fairways, according to its representatives.
